The student, however, is responsible for maintenance and any/all repairs that fall outside of the normal use of the instrument (i.e. excessive dents, abusive treatment, etc.) The following are considered a part of this instrument contract:

1. The student will properly care for and maintain the instrument. This includes cleaning and replacing strings when appropriate. The student will notify the orchestra director of any problems with the instrument as soon as possible.
2. The student will replace the instrument up to its value during the time of this contract if it is lost or damaged beyond repair.
3. The instrument will be stored in its designated space in the orchestra room, and in a safe place at home.
4. The instrument will not be used in any organization other than those sponsored by Maus MS without the consent of the orchestra director or administration.
5. The student will allow no one else to play or handle the instrument.
6. The student will make a proper effort to improve him/herself on the instrument.
7. The instrument will be returned to the director within 24 hours whenever called for.
8. **Fees: \$100 for the school year (all instruments). This year fees for renting a school instrument will be paid in ONLINE SCHOOL FEES through the district.**

Maus Orchestra Private Lesson Sign- Up Form

Private lessons may occur before, during, before, or after the school day. This is a great opportunity for your student to get one-on-one attention with an expert on their instrument so they can further their skills as a musician. Lessons are available at a cost of \$23 per lesson for a 23 minute session per week.

Parents are responsible for making payments to the private teachers on time and on a scheduled determined by each individual teacher. Students are usually asked to pay for their lessons a month at a time. Returned checks should be avoided.

Parents are responsible for fees associated as a result of a returned check.

All students in the Mountain Lion Orchestra are encouraged to enroll in private lessons. Students who take advantage of this excellent program learn at a faster pace and have a better understanding of their music. Spots in a teacher's schedule will be filled on a first come-first served basis. If a waiting list occurs students will be notified if a spot opens up in the order their lessons request was received.

Directors approve lesson scheduling. Students/parents may not change lesson times without prior director approval. Missing lessons for more than one week may result in an orchestra change.

Signing up for lessons is a yearlong commitment. You may not quit lessons until the end of the school year.
